# SCRIPTURE READINGS—YEAR A 2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME Let us hear and receive the word of god



# FIRST READING: Isaiah 49: 3, 5-6.

The Lord said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will be glorified." And now the Lord says, who formed me in the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob back to him, and that Israel might be gathered to him, for I am honoured in the sight of the Lord, and my God has become my strength. He says, "It is too small a thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to restore the survivors of Israel; I will give you as a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth."

# RESPONSORIAL PSALM : Ps 39: 2-4, 7-10

#### R: Here I am, Lord; I come to do your will.

l waited patiently for the Lord; he inclined to me and heard my cry. He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. R.

Sacrifice and offering you do not desire, but you have given me an open ear. Burnt offering and sin offering you have not required. R.

#### GOSPEL: John 1: 29-34

I myself did not know him; but I came baptising with water for this reason, that he might be revealed to Israel."

And John testified, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and remain on him. I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptise with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain is the one who baptises with the Holy Spirit.' And I myself have seen and have testified that this is the Son of God."

The Shed in Mt Druitt, is a drop in centre for people at

risk of suicide, originally a space for Aboriginal men in distress, now open to anyone who comes.

It is based on the research on the social determinants of health, more specifically, the determinants of distress and suicide; the Shed links people to the services of which they are most in need.

A free lunch is offered every Wednesday at the Shed. Service providers such as Centrelink, Public Housing, Podiatrist, Health Bus also visit to listen to the voice of the community, and assist in any way they can.
